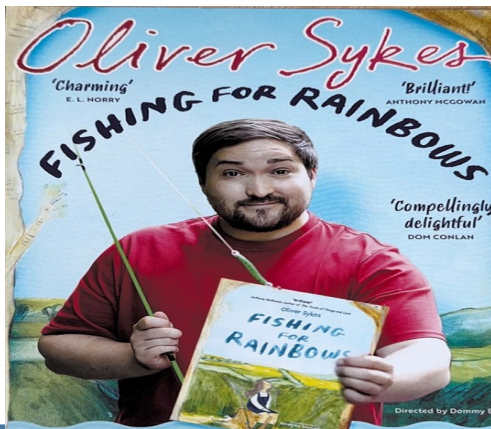

School Dinner Money/Breakfast Club/ After School Club Fees

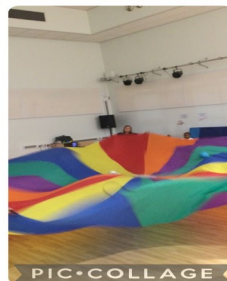

Amazing Attendance & Perfect Punctuality

Well done to all children that are continuing to make it to school on time. The number of late children has decreased this week, thank you for supporting your child in getting to school on time. We understand that on occasion your child may be late for school, it does however become a concern if this then becomes regular.

Lateness = Lost learning (Figures are calculated over the year)	
5 minutes late each day	3 days lost
10 minutes late each day	6.5 days lost
15 minutes late each day	10 days lost
20 minutes late each day	13 days lost
30 minutes late each day	19 days lost

The week before we broke up for the half term holidays our whole school attendance was 92.6%. Our whole school attendance for this week has improved to 93.1%. Our whole school attendance to date has also improved and is now 92.7%. Let's work together to get even closer to meeting our attendance goal of 96%. 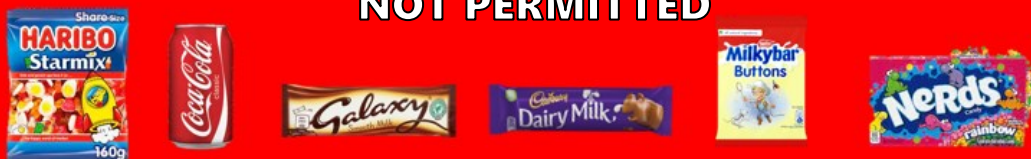
