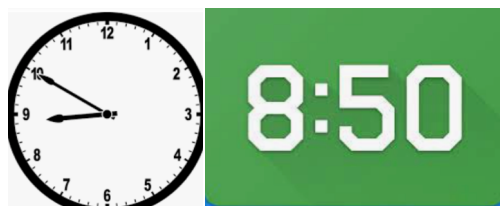

ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY UPDATE

We are pleased to announce that our BIG PUSH to improve attendance and punctuality is having a positive effect and this week the numbers of children absent each day decreased. This is FANTASTIC. We are also seeing fewer children arriving late in the mornings which is also FABULOUS NEWS!

Please remember that Varley Street is closed at the moment and this may affect your journey to school if you drive. Please set off a little earlier until the road re-opens so that your child is not late!

If children arrive on the playground by ten to nine, they can never be late!



Though our attendance is improving, we have noticed that there is a higher absence rate on Fridays. We will be looking at the registers closely and if children are repeatedly absent on a Friday then we will contact parents/carers to discuss this. Please remember, if your child's attendance falls below 96% we will ask you to provide medical evidence for all absences until the child meets or exceeds this target again. We will not be able to authorise an absence without the medical evidence in these circumstances. High levels of unauthorised absence can result in parents/carers being fined.
