On our worst day this school year we had almost 80 children absent (which is nearly 20% of our school population) and on Wednesday 2nd February 2022 we only had 11 children absent (which is less than 3%).

As we have said before, patterns established in early childhood and throughout primary school affect the rest of a child's life. Giving your child the gift of good organisation, resilience and commitment will help them to become a successful young person and adult in the future.
