### Return to school on March 8<sup>th</sup>

Thank you for all your hard work over the past few months supporting your children to learn at home. We are now looking forward to welcoming them back on Monday. Here are a few reminders.

Please follow the procedures on the next page when entering the school premises, making sure that you are wearing a face covering and maintaining social distance.

We have reviewed our arrangements for Y5/Y6 and EYFS children entering the school via the front gate. To improve social distancing, we have installed a new small gate just to the left of the main double gate. This is for Y5 and Y6 children and anyone who needs to access the school office. EYFS children should continue to enter via the double gates.

Start and finish times are EXACTLY the same in December 2020:

nursery arrive 9.05am and finish 2.55pm (via large double gate at front of school)

reception arrive 9.05am and finish 3.10pm (via large double gate at front of school)

Y1 arrive 9.00am and finish 3.05pm (via yellow gate on KS2 playground)

Y2 arrive 8.50am and finish 2.55pm (via yellow gate on KS2 playground))

Y3 arrive 9.00am and finish 3.15pm (via back large gate on KS1 playground)

Y4 arrive 8.50am and finish 3.05pm (via back large gate on KS1 playground)


Y5 arrive 9.00am and finish 3.15pm (via small green gate at front of school)

Y6 arrive 8.50am and finish 3.05pm (via small green gate at front of school)

Children can wear PE kits on their PE days. Teachers will remind parents of these days next week.
