Firstly, we remind you that the yellow zig-zags outside the front of school should be left clear at all times.

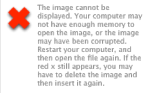
Secondly, cars should not be parked on yellow lines or pavements.

Stay 2 metres away from other people when bringing your child through the school grounds.



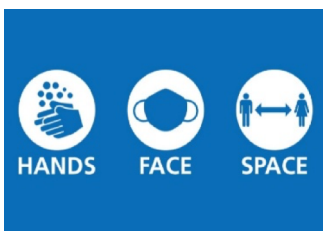
Just ONE adult at drop off and pick up times.
