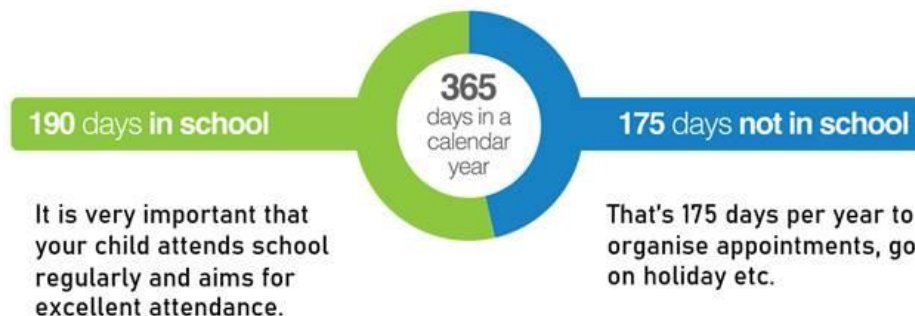

We know that it may happen on occasion, but it is a concern if it begins to happen regularly. We are currently having about 35 pupils late each day. This is extremely disruptive and creates a lot of work for the office staff. We start at 8.50am.

Last week the whole school attendance was 92.4%. Our whole school attendance has improved massively to 94.3%. Our whole school attendance to date is 93.4%. Let's work even harder to meet our attendance target of 96%.
