# Attendance and Punctuality Update

Attendance is currently 94.5%. Our school target is 96%. 12.4% of children are classed as 'persistent absentees' as their attendance has dropped below 90%. 5.2% of these pupils are unauthorised holidays .Punctuality is 93.3%. 34 children (20 families) frequently arrive after the doors close at 9.00am.

Next term we will be holding another 100% attendance day where all children present are entered into a prize draw to win a £20 voucher of their choice. We will let you know the date as soon as possible.
