#### Nasal Flu Vaccination

The Flu Vaccination will be held on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> November for Reception to Year 6. If you have not yet returned your consent form, please do so as soon as possible.

The nasal spray flu vaccine is used to help prevent seasonal flu (influenza) in children aged 2 to 17 years. It provides better protection against flu than the flu jab in children this age.

Flu can be a very unpleasant illness for children, giving them a very poorly week in bed. It can also potentially lead to serious complications such as

pneumonia, bronchitis or ear infections. When children are given the vaccine it not only protects them from flu, but also helps to reduce the spread of flu and thus protect many others, such as babies, grandparents, pregnant women and other people who run an increased risk of serious complications such as pneumonia if they catch the flu.
