Use of social media at home

We are experiencing issues in school that are related to children's online and media activities at home. Some children are arguing online out of school hours and then the issues continue in school. Most social media platforms and popular games are not designed for primary ages children with the majority rated at 13 years or over therefore our children should not be accessing these platforms. We suggest that parents/carers close down these platforms/remove games. However, those parents/carers choosing to allow their children to access them, we strongly recommend that you supervise and monitor their use.

School will deal with issues that arise from social media misuse if it impacts on relationships during the school day via our usual behaviour management procedures. However, protecting children from online abuse is a parental responsibility. For each issue created online out of school hours that continues in school is time taken away from staff that would be better spent on supporting learning and pupil progress.

Please help us to make the best use of teaching and learning by removing any age-inappropriate social media platforms/games from your children's devices at home or closely monitoring your child's online activities.
