Reporting COVID cases over Christmas

If your child becomes unwell and tests positive for COVID between 19th and 24th December, school must inform parents/carers of children and staff that your child may have had contact with during the last week of term. Should your child test positive on or during these dates please send an email to admin@parkview.manchester.sch.uk stating your child's name, class and date of test and results, type of symptoms and the date the symptoms started. A member school staff will inform any contacts they have had in school and advise them that they must isolate for 10 days. You may also receive a call from a staff member to discuss your child's case.

If your child tests positive after 24th December, he/she and the whole household must self-isolate for the time period advised by track and trace. Please contact school on 5th January 2021 via telephone to report if your child is still in isolation due to COVID. Please also report, in the usual way, any other illness that may prevent your child from returning to school on 5th January.
