Safety in the Community

We have spoken to children over the week in classrooms and assemblies about keeping themselves safe on Bonfire Night. We have told children to stay a safe distance from bonfires and fireworks and to stay with an adult.

Now that it is getting dark earlier in the evenings, we would advise that children play at home rather than outside during the evenings. Those older children who walk home alone should be encouraged to go straight home after school.

A child in our school was bitten by a dog on the way to school earlier this week. Luckily the injury was not serious but we have been advised by the local police to ensure that parents/carers are aware that dogs can be a risk to children and to ensure that your children stay close to you when encountering dogs on the way to or from school.

Packed Lunch Protocol

As a healthy school we advise parents/carers not to include sweets, chocolate bars and fizzy drinks in packed lunches. We are launching new guidelines shortly about what is permitted in a packed lunch in school. We know that the vast majority of parents/carers are supportive and stick to the healthy guidelines we recommend. We will continue to send back home items that are not permitted and would greatly appreciate it if parents/carers can keep these types of foods at home for after school treats

Why is PUNCTUALITY so important?

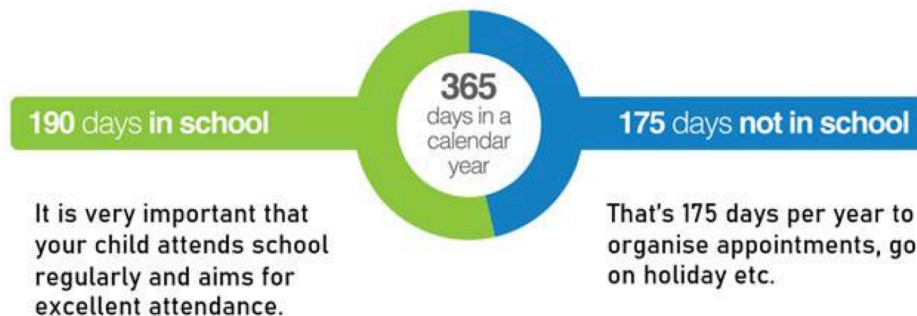
It gets your child's day off to a good start.
