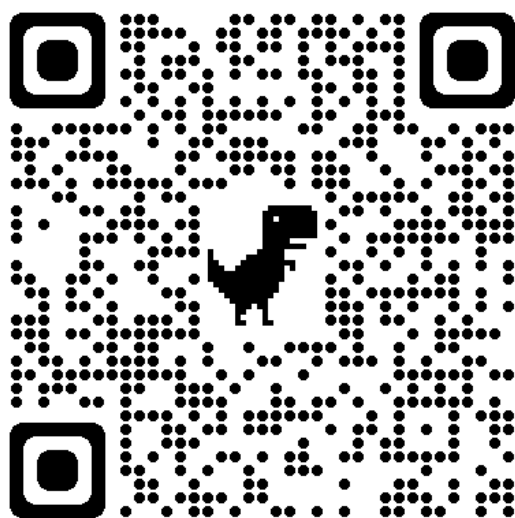
Help with the cost of living crisis

Why is PUNCTUALITY so important?

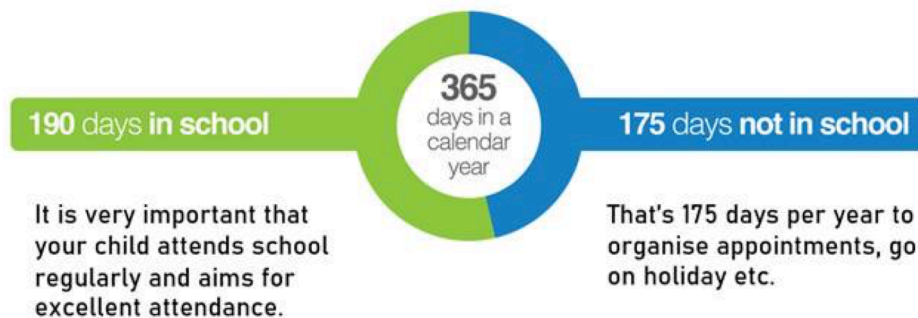
It gets your child's day off to a good start.
